U.S. Census: Workers are canvassing neighborhoods to verify address information for the 2010 Census. Be sure and ask for identification before answering questions from anyone who comes to your door. Here are some things you should know according to the Better Business Bureau: A legitimate Census worker will have a badge, handheld device, Census Bureau canvas bag and confidentiality notice. The bureau warned residents **NOT** to give anyone their Social Security number, credit card or banking information. If some one should ask for this info immediately notify authorizes.

Roofs and Hail Damage... There have been over 40 homes that have had their roofs replaced. The Architectural Control Committee and the Board urges all that haven't had their roof looked at to do so. We suggest that you have a roofer look at the roof first then call your insurance co. They can help you get this done. Also, use the map that shows all the roofs that have been replaced.
